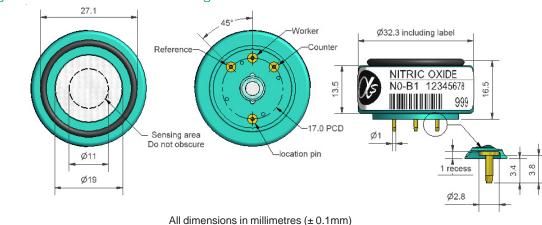

## Figure 2 Sensitivity Temperature Dependence

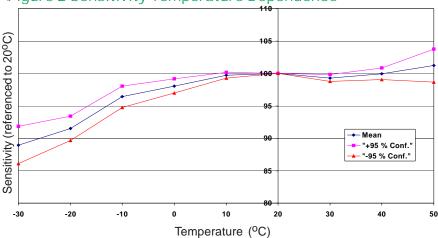


Figure 2 shows the variation in sensitivity caused by changes in temperature.

Figure 3 Zero Temperature Dependence

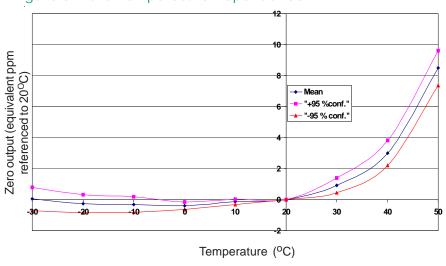
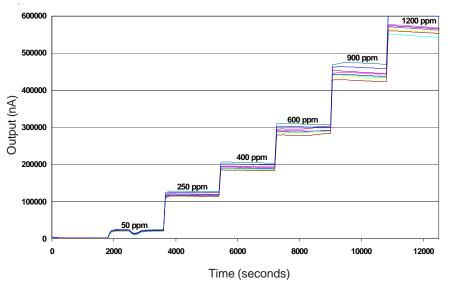


Figure 3 shows the variation in zero output caused by changes in temperature expressed at ppm gas equivalent.
